Our keynote speaker is Janine Latus – award winning journalist, speaker, advocate and international bestselling author of *If I Am Missing or Dead* – the story of two sisters who fall victim to angry and controlling partners. One breaks free and thrives; the other is murdered by her live-in boyfriend. Janine survived. Now, she travels the world openly speaking on sexual assault and intimate partner violence to the United States Navy, various universities, shelters, Major League Baseball teams, and corporations as the idea that ‘what happens in the home, stays in the home’ is leading to people being killed. Janine advocates for people to share their stories, which frees and empowers others to tell their stories. Her presentations are part-story, part-strategy, based on the Duluth Power and Control Wheel – full of practicality as theory is developed within personal accounts – resonating long after everyone has left the room.

Did you know that the moment an abuse survivor decides to leave is also their most dangerous and vulnerable time? Your generous donations provide life-saving emergency services that mitigate danger, provide safe shelter, and position survivors for long-term success.

- **\$1,500** supports a parent & two children for one week with emergency shelter, where they can devise a safety plan & access resources to relocate to a safe support system.
- **\$1,500** assists an assault survivor with free advocacy & counseling for up to three months.
- **\$2,500** helps survivors access safe shelter, resources, & if needed, housing & assistance for their beloved family pets.
- **\$2,500** aids a families in need of housing support while seeking employment.
- **\$5,000** supports an entire month of Summer Kids Camp for 20 children.
- **\$7,500** provides 1,600 adolescents with targeted education focused on the importance of healthy relationships during their most critical development stage.
- **\$10,000** goes a long way, providing one of the following:
 - Trained and qualified staff to provide one month's 24-hour crisis support & care.
 - Emergency shelter, advocacy, and counseling for a family for one month.
 - Educational groups in three schools for a full school year.
