- A cultural healing recognition during our candlelight vigil, led by Lillian Tsosie-Jensen born Yellow Woman, member of the Dineh' Nation. Her clan is Bitter Water, born for the Danish People. Lillian is a Traditional Practitioner
- A community mural dedicated to survivors and memorials with contributions from attendees.
- Local vendors offering support, including food trucks, local businesses and informational tables.
- An appearance from the Tooele chapter of Bikers Against Child Abuse (BACA).
