Scam Warning: SVS warns public of fraudulent fundraising activity

UTAH — March 13, 2026 — We have been made aware of a fraudulent fundraising effort currently circulating in our community. The individual behind this is engaging in unauthorized solicitation, using false materials designed to look affiliated with SVS, using our outdated logo and a graphic that appears to be AI generated. These materials include graphics and branding that mimic our official content but were not created or approved by our organization.

We want to make the following clear:

- SVS will not publicly release identifying information about active clients or their children, especially in conjunction with fundraising.
- We do not conduct or promote public fundraisers for individual clients.
- Any donation drives or requests for support are organized and communicated directly through official SVS staff or explicitly approved partners.
