Earlier in her tenure, **she served for six years as BYU's Title IX Coordinator, overseeing cases involving sexual assault, dating violence, domestic violence, stalking, and sexual harassment.**

Before her time at BYU, Tiffany worked for more than a decade with the State of Utah, including roles with the Department of Workforce Services, the state legislature, and the Governor's Office.
